Mr. Cannon was presented Life Membership in the Jaycees in 1966. He was also a member of the Conway Kiwanis Club, past Deacon of First Baptist Church of Conway and past Conway City Councilman. He was a member of Masonic Lodge #165 and a life member of the Waccamaw Shrine Club Pedalers. Surviving are his wife, Joan Harrington Cannon of Conway, two sons; Jimmy Cannon and his wife Fedora and Rodney Cannon and his wife Tamra both of Conway, SC, three grandchildren; Lee Cannon, Colby Cannon and McCall Cannon, a sister; Elizabeth Hearl of North Augusta.
