Conway...J. Phillip Spruill, 83, of Conway, passed away from this life on Monday, December 03, 2012.

Mr. Spruill was born February 8, 1929 in Creswell, NC to the late Phillip Murray Spruill and Anna Iolia Turner Spruill. He was also predeceased by his sister, Winnifred Brickhouse of Columbia, NC, his brother, William Murray Spruill of Creswell, NC and a daughter, Sandra L. Spruill of Moss Point, MS. Mr. Spruill was retired from the US Air Force. After retiring from the military, he worked as an engineer with NASA at the Mississippi Test Facility during the Apollo Space Program. He also worked for a time with the Mississippi Housing Authority before getting into property development which brought him to South Carolina to work with Defender Industries in Columbia. In 1985, Mr. Spruill started the Defender Property Management Division in Myrtle Beach and purchased that portion of the company in 1988. Mr. Spruill was co-owner of Defender Resorts until 1998. He was also involved in several other business ventures, and was an active member of the Georgetown Church of Christ.

Mr. Spruill is survived by his wife, Lorna McKinney Spruill of Conway, his daughter, Beverly J. Spruill of Conway, eight grandchildren, thirteen great grandchildren; four sisters, LaQuita Gibbs of Williamsburg, VA, Janice Woodley of Creswell, NC, Jayne Opher of Benson, NC, Brenda Spruill of Edenton, NC and many extended family.
