James Wilson Webb, Jr. died Sunday, January 31, 2016 at Conway Medical Center.

Mr. Webb was born in Brunson, South Carolina, the son of the late James Wilson Webb, Sr. and Tinye Brunson Webb. Mr. Webb graduated as valedictorian from the Brunson School and attended Clemson University in 1940 where he was a member of ROTC, and after serving in the U.S. Army during World War II, returned and graduated from Clemson University in 1947. Mr. Webb received commission as 1st Lieutenant in 1944 and was assigned to the 11th Airborne Division in 1945. In addition to his service in World War II, Mr. Webb served in the Korean War during 1951-52.

Mr. Webb worked as a teacher in his native Brunson, S.C., and then with GMAC before joining Palmetto Chevrolet in Conway in August of 1953, where he has served as office manager for nearly 63 years. He was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church in Conway, and is a 72-year member of IPTAY.

Mr. Webb was predeceased by his wife, Miriam Holmes "Mickey" Webb; a sister, Mary Emily Pow; and a brother, W. Frank Webb.

Surviving are one son, Jimmy Webb of Florence; and one daughter, Melinda W. Hyman and her husband, Craig of Conway; one sister, Clara W. Maxwell of Florence; one granddaughter, Katherine S. Smith and her husband, Woody of Conway; and one great-grandson, Rowe Smith of Conway.

A memorial service will be held at 4:00 PM Tuesday, February 2, 2016 at

Trinity United Methodist Church with Rev. Dr. Sandra Stevens Poirel officiating. The family will receive friends following the memorial service in the church Fellowship Hall. Burial will be private at Lakeside Cemetery.

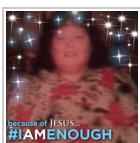
