Loris... "J.C." Howard Graham, age 80, went to be with the Lord Monday, November 19, 2012.

Mr. Graham was born January 10, 1932 in Conway, SC. He was the son of the late George Ellie Graham, Sr. and Addie Magnolia Gunter Graham. Mr. Graham was an active member of Conway Church of God. He assisted in putting up the first tent building for Conway Church of God and helped to build the first wooden church. He also helped build the first brick church and parsonage on the corner of Fulmer and Sessions Street and several other building projects. Mr. Graham served on the Christian Education Board, the Pastors Council, and on the Planning Committee for the present church on Cultra Road. He served over 20 years as Clerk and Treasurer of the church. His love for God and raising a Christian family were his priorities but he also liked to fish and was known throughout Horry County, North Carolina, Georgia, Maryland, and Indiana for his expertise in repairing farm equipment and restoring old tractors. Mr. Graham's knowledge of tractors and the like earned him the nickname of "The Tractor Man/Doctor". It has been said, "If J.C. can't fix it, well, it can't be fixed." He worked for Massey Ferguson in Homewood many years before opening his own business on Cultra Road in Conway and then relocated to Blue Bird Road in Loris, SC. Mr. Graham was also predeceased by three brothers George Ellie Graham (Junior), Willie Joe Graham and Paul Eugene Graham; and two sisters, Leola Graham and Lucille Rogers Allen.

He is survived by his loving wife of 58 years, Ellen. "Annie" Sessions Graham. two daughters, Diana Parker and husband James of Conway, and Annette Duncan and husband Milton of Little River; one son, Jeff Graham and wife Ashley of Greenville, NC. two grandchildren, Jarame Parker of Conway, and Joseph Duncan and wife Rebecca of Greenville, SC.; four sisters, Margaret Martin, Leona Ellison, Gladys Sessions all of Conway and Bonnie Causey of Florida.

Funeral services will be held at 3:00 PM Friday from Conway Church of God with Rev. Stuart Jacobs and Rev. James Goude officiating. Burial will follow in Hillcrest Cemetery.

The family will receive friends from 6:00 PM until 8:00 PM Wednesday at the funeral home.
