Georgetown, SC--Jeffrey S. Doerr, age 61 of the Debordieu Colony in Georgetown, SC, and formerly of Clifton Park, NY., passed away on Thursday, May 20, 2010 after a long valiant battle with cancer. Jeff was born in Lancaster, Pa. A son of Mary Jane Doerr and the late Harry B. Doerr. Jeff attended Lancaster Catholic High School and graduated from Loyola College in Maryland on a basketball scholarship obtaining a BA in Political Science in 1971; he served as a Captain in the United States Army from 1972 to 1985. Jeff earned his law degree from St. Mary's University School of Law in San Antonio TX in 1977 where he served as editor of the Law Review. He was senior partner in the law firm Overton, Russell, Doerr and Donovan in Clifton Park, NY until he retired to Georgetown SC a few years ago. Jeff leaves his family and friends with the memory of complete loyalty and devotion. As a loving father he participated in many of his childrens' recreational activities, including coaching softball teams for more than 10 years. He had a passion for travel and a particular fondness for his dogs, Chaos and Nyla. He set a good example that anything could be achieved with hard work. In spite of his illness he still attempted to live each day to the fullest. His family and friends will deeply miss his advice, insight, intellect and companionship. He has left an emptiness in the hearts of all who knew him. Jeff was the devoted husband of 25 years to Wendy M. Doerr; he also leaves behind four children whom he loved dearly; Kristen Doerr and Katelyn Doerr both of Georgetown, SC, Kye Doerr of Seattle, WA. And Jonathan Doerr of Las Vegas, NV. Jeff was the

beloved brother of Suzanne Meisel and her husband, Mark of Salisbury, MD. Jeff is also survived by two nephews and five nieces.
