Conway...Jerry Edsol Edge, age 71, lifelong resident of the Brown Swamp section of Horry County lost his battle with melanoma cancer on Saturday, December 5, 2009. Mr. Edge was born in Conway, a son of the late Ira Hubert and Maggie Dell Davis Edge. He graduated from Conway High school and attended Coastal Carolina College. Mr. Edge was a lifelong active member and leader of Brown Swamp United Methodist Church. He was a lifelong farmer, winning and earning numerous honors and awards throughout his life and was named the Southeastern Farmer of the Year in 1998. Mr. Edge served as President of the Bucksport Water System for many years and served on many other boards, both locally and statewide. He served as Chairman of the Horry County Farm Service Agency. Mr. Edge was preceded in death by two infant brothers.
