Conway..... Jesse James Glasgow, III, age 48, died Tuesday, August 2, 2016. Mr. Glasgow was born in Ft. Sill, OK, a son of the late Jesse James Glasgow, Jr. and the late Gaye Chryst Glasgow. Jesse received his B.A. from USC Coastal Carolina College and his M.B.A. from Winthrop University. He was a long-time employee of Blue Cross/Blue Shield of South Carolina.

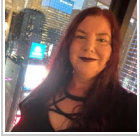

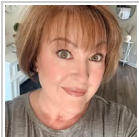
