Jesse Clyde Lee age 99, died Thursday, June 4, 2015 at his residence. Born in Conway, SC, he was a son of the late Joseph Holton and Rosa Holden Lee. Mr. Lee was a WWII U.S. Army veteran. He was co-owner of Lee Brothers Lumber Company and retired from Brookgreen Gardens in March of 1981. He was an outdoorsman and enjoyed his garden and flowers and was the last of 10 children. He was preceded in death by his wife, Mattie Miller Lee of Murrells Inlet and 9 brothers and sisters and their spouses.

Survivors include a daughter, Jo Anne Lee of Murrells Inlet; a son, Roderick Clyde Lee and his wife Katherine Mason of Augusta, GA; 28 nephews and nieces.

My prayers go to his family and especially Joanne. We will miss him.

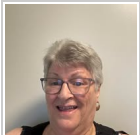
