Jim Mishoe, 82, passed away at home surrounded by his family on Tuesday, November 10, 2020. Born March 9, 1938 in Conway SC, he was the son of the late James Earl (Sue) Mishoe and Louise Wilson Mishoe. Mr. Mishoe graduated from Conway High School in 1956 when he began working for the family business B&M Tire Service in Conway, where he continued until this year.
