Jimmy E. Davis age 78, died Tuesday, October 13, 2015 at his residence. Born June 1, 1937, in Georgetown County he attended Winyah High School and in 1954 joined the United States Air Force where he proudly served his country for 26 years. His career saw duty assignments in France, Germany, Libya, Japan, Philippines and Thailand. While stationed at Myrtle Beach Air Force Base he was Maintenance Superintendent for OMS and AGS Squadrons. His assignment upon retirement in May 1980 was 354 TFW Aircraft Maintenance Superintendent. Jimmy loved his work and wished he had served longer. He was also a Master Mason with Socastee Lodge No. 421. He was preceded in death by his parents, Jasper (Jack) C. and Leila Davis; four brothers, and three sisters.

He is survived by his loving wife of 56 years, Clara of Surfside; his son, Kenneth of Beaufort, SC; his daughter, Debra Esch (George) of Myrtle Beach; his granddaughter, Jodi Brideschge of Myrtle Beach; his sister, Reba Cusack of Georgetown, SC; his step-sister, Patsy Enloe of Winnsboro, SC; a special family friend, Kenneth Harwell who he loved as his second son, and 22 nieces and nephews.

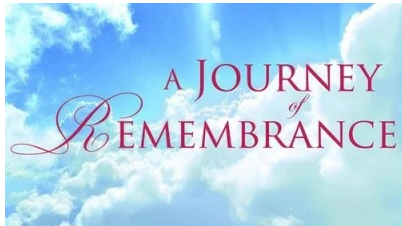
