Conway...Joanne Crowgey Loggins, died Wednesday, December 4, 2013 at Conway Medical Center following a short illness. She was born in Roanoke, VA, the daughter of the late Betty Lindamood and William Perry Crowgey, Jr. Mrs. Loggins was predeceased by her brother, William Earl Crowgey. She is survived by her son, David William Loggins; her grandson, William Blake Loggins; her sister and brother-in-law, Jane Crowgey and Gary Olin Crenshaw; as well as loving nieces and nephews; and her stepson, Mike Loggins.

The Crowgey family moved to Conway in 1954 following Hurricane Hazel. The Crowgey family were charter members of Trinity United Methodist Church. Mrs. Loggins graduated from Conway High School in 1964, earned her undergraduate degree from VCU in Richmond, VA, her master's degree from Rollins College in Winter Park, FL, and her PHD from University of Central Florida in Orlando, FL. She retired after many years of service and after touching thousands of lives of children in the public schools of North Carolina and Florida. Mrs. Loggins was instrumental as principal in establishing Lake George Elementary School in Orlando. After her retirement, she returned to Conway to care for her parents, where she continued to work with the children of Horry County and worked as Personnel Advisor to Great Clips. As a member of the Camellia Garden Club, she served as former president and was current president of Conway Garden Club's Council.

A graveside service will be held 11:00 AM Friday December 13, at Hillcrest

Cemetery. The family will visit with friends after the service.
