SURFSIDE BEACH..John Barnwell Wallace, age 81 of North Poplar Drive, died Monday, February 6, 2006 at Waccamaw Community Hospital. Born April 18, 1924 in Clover, SC a son of the late Thomas Wilds and Nettie Willis Wallace. Mr. Wallace graduated from Florence High School in 1941, was a US Army World War II Veteran from 1942-1946 in the European Theater and in Japan in the 387th Infantry Division. Mr. Wallace attended Clemson University. He was co-owner of and operator of Coastal Glass Company in Myrtle Beach until retirement in 1978. Mr. Wallace was a member of the Episcopal Church of the Resurrection since 1957 and was a vestry member and EYC Leader of the Episcopal Church. He was a Boy Scout leader, life member of Murrells Inlet Masonic Lodge #368, the Shriners, and American Legion Life Member. Mr. Wallace was pre-deceased by his wife: Helen Wallace. Surviving are one son: Jack Wallace and wife Lynn of Raleigh, North Carolina; two daughters: Kathy Mishoe and husband Marcus of Myrtle Beach and Mary McCutchen and husband Bobby of Pawleys Island; four grandchildren: Nicholas Mishoe of Myrtle Beach, Russell and Jonathan McCutchen both of Pawleys Island and Beau Wallace of Raleigh, North Carolina.
