



## John DiMaria, Jr.

John DiMaria passed away peacefully on January 31 2015 at the age 67, in his home at Lakeview Circle, Pawley's Island South Carolina. John lived in Rockaway Township, New Jersey before moving to Pawleys Island, SC over a year ago.

He was born in Lodi, New Jersey, on October 22, 1947 and was the son of the late John and Josephine DiMaria. John earned a Bachelor's Degree in History from Fairleigh Dickenson University. John served as councilman for over 20 years and was on the planning board for 30 years. He was also a Member Republican County Committee and he was the Chairman of "Rockaway Township Days". He was also active in coaching girls and boy's recreation and travel basketball, softball, baseball, and soccer in Rockaway Township and was an avid New York Giants fan and golfer.
