Mr. John Anthony Dusenbury, 66, of Saint Helena Island, SC passed away peacefully in Savannah, GA on Sunday, April 1, 2018 with his family at his side.

Born May 18, 1951 in Conway, SC, John was the son of the late Reginald Dusenbury and the late Vera Cherry Dusenbury. Mr. Dusenbury was a 1969 graduate of Conway High School and received his associates in Accounting from Horry Georgetown Technical College in 1972. Most of his life, Mr. Dusenbury was self-employed and early on had many business ventures to include a doughnut delivery service, beach snow cone cart routes, several 'greasy spoons', and multiple roadside firework and produce stands. He also had short endeavors as insurance and real estate sales agents. His most notable career efforts were made in the shellfish industry, where he focused on wholesale oyster and clam sales for nearly 40 years and was known to many as the "oyster-man".

John enjoyed spending time with his family, hunting, fishing, playing billiards, and had a strong passion for anything outdoors, particularly the beach. Mr. Dusenbury was predeceased by his former spouse, Virginia Ann Dusenbury, his brother, Charles "Chuck" Dusenbury, his sister, Andra Dell Gore, and biological father, Andy Spivey.
