John "Jack" Gilbert Stevens, age 77 of Patriot Lane died Saturday, September 17, 2005 at the Lakes at Litchfield. Born May 31, 1928 in Manhattan, NY, he was the son of the late John R. and Beulah Wood Stevens. Major Stevens was a Korean War, US Air Force veteran serving as a Sabre and Phantom Fighter Pilot. He was shot down and held as a P.O.W. for eighteen months. Major Stevens worked with Northrup for six years serving as a consultant for Saudia Arabia pilots. He was a member of All Saints Church. Surviving are his wife, Patricia Stevens; son, Mark Stevens and wife Kim; daughter, Patricia Hock and husband Ron all of Ft. Walton Beach, FL; seven grandchildren and seven great grandchildren. Memorial services will be 10:00 AM, Friday at All Saints Church with a reception following in the ACTS Building. Inurnment will be later in John F. Robinson Mausoleum, Spring Grove Cemetery in Cincinnati, OH. The family will receive friends from 4:00-7:00, Thursday at the family residence.
