John H. Robinson John Harold Robinson, 89 died Wednesday, June 17, 2009 at National Healthcare of Garden City. Born in Uniontown, PA, he was the son of the late Eliza and John L. Robinson. Mr. Robinson was a World War II, US Army Air Force veteran serving as a First Lieutenant B-26 pilot in England. He was a graduate of Penn State University and from the University of Pennsylvania Law School and was admitted into practice in Fayette County, PA. Mr. Robinson also served as an attorney in the tax division for the US Steel Corp. He resided in western PA until moving to Surfside Beach, SC in 1985 where he was a member of the Episcopal Church of the Resurrection. His wife, Margaret Rowland Robinson preceded him in death. Surviving are his sons, Robert Robinson of Surfside Beach and John L. Robinson of Michigan and his grandchildren, Denise and Christopher Robinson both of Michigan.
