



## John Mark Johnson

November 21, 1936 - February 20, 2017

Mr. J. Mark Johnson, age 80, husband of Mrs. Mamie Dorman Johnson, passed away at his home on Monday, February 20, 2017.

He was born November 21, 1936 in Conway, SC, a son of the late Thomas Jefferson and Zera Pervis Johnson. In addition to his parents, Mr. Johnson was also preceded in death by three brothers, S.C. Johnson, Thomas Lloyd Johnson, and Jeff Johnson; a sister, Louise Enloe; and a daughter-in-law, Lisa Johnson.

Mr. Johnson was a graduate of Aynor High School. He later enlisted in the United States Coast Guard and retired as Senior Master Chief Electrician (E-9) after 22 years of service.
