Dr. John Everett King, 56 of Myrtle Beach passed away, Thursday, July 1, 2010 at Waccamaw Community Hospital following a brief and courageous battle with an aggressive cancer. Born in Queens, NY, he was the son of the late William E. King, MD and Elizabeth (King) Porter, MD. For the past seventeen years, Dr. King practiced internal medicine passionately for his patients here in Myrtle Beach. The rare hours of private time, he treasured being a "homebody" with his wife and spending time with family. Surviving are his wife of over 21 years, Jill; son, Drew Romeo and wife Lauren of Northville, MI; precious granddaughter, Charley Elaine Romeo; brother, William B. King, MD; sisters, Elizabeth Henkel and Mary King Pruitt and a host of uncles, aunts, nieces and nephews. The following day Dr. King with Chanika's assistance got me off of those terrible medications and truly saved my life. I can never express my gratitude to Dr. King enough for saving my life. He has worked over the past four years to improve my quality of life. He was always willing to try something new to help me. Jill, many of our conversations in the office turned towards you and how much he loved you and cherished his time with you. He talked beamingly of Drew, his wife and their son, his grandson. He was probably always running late in the office because he spent extra time with all of his patients. He truly was an exceptional Doctor. I am forever grateful to have had him in my life. God probably needed someone to make house calls in heaven. My sincere sympathies go to you and your family during this difficult time.
