John L. Moore, age 72, of Myrtle Beach, died Tuesday, March 6, 2012 at Grand Strand Regional Medical Center.

Mr. Moore was born in Cambridge, MA, to the late Charles and Marie Moore. He was a member of The Catholic Church of St. James where he served as Eucharistic Minister, worked on the Parish Council and on the Capital Improvement Fund Committee. Mr. Moore also served as treasurer for the DAV, was a member of the VFW, worked as a volunteer at the election polls and donated many years of service to the Boy Scouts of America. He retired from the United States Air Force after 33 years of service, serving during Vietnam and the Gulf War.

He was preceded in death by his daughter, Debra M. Moore.

Mr. Moore was a loving husband, father, grandfather and great grandfather and will be missed.
