John J. Partyka age 66, died Tuesday, July 13, 2021.

Born in Trenton, NJ, he was the son of the late Frank and Mary (Gayzik) Partyka. John was a graduate of Trenton Central High School and the University of South Carolina. He retired in 2008 from General Motors Corporation with 31 yrs. of service. Most of those years were spent at the Ewing, NJ plant before transferring to Doraville, GA. He lived in Alpharetta, GA before retiring to Myrtle Beach. He was an avid golfer and fisherman and spent many years coaching his children's athletic teams.
