Jack Shriver, Jr, 80, of Patriot Lane died Tuesday, November 5, 2013 at Tideland Hospice House in Georgetown.

Born in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late John and Margaret Shriver. Mr. Shriver was a veteran of the US Army and was a graduate of the University of Loyola in Baltimore, MD. He was a director of logistics for Zimmer, Inc., a division of Bristol Myers Squibb. Mr. Shriver retired to Pawleys Island in 1997 and was a member of Precious Blood of Christ Catholic Church where he served as a lector and Eucharistic minister.
