Johnelle Copeland Webster age 84, devoted wife, mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother, passed away Thursday, September 1, 2022, at her residence.

Born in Rockingham, NC, she was a daughter of the late John and Nelle Copeland.

Johnelle or “Johnnie” to most was a 1956 graduate of Rockingham High School and a 1960 graduate of Flora Mac Donald College. She married Henry W. Webster on June 25, 1960, and the couple’s first stop was Fort Lee, VA where Henry served in the U.S. Army Quartermaster Corp. Johnnie accepted her first teaching job in the nearby town of Hopewell, VA. Following Henry’s military assignment, she taught school wherever Henry’s work took them. She taught in Clinton, Raeford and Oakboro, NC. When Henry returned to North Carolina State University for graduate school, Johnnie taught in Franklinton, NC. After two years and a master’s degree, Henry attended Clemson University for his doctorate degree and Johnnie taught at Wren Middle School in South Carolina. Johnnie enjoyed teaching and she loved her students. Rewards were in seeing her students succeed in the classroom and later in life. As a member of Ocean Drive Presbyterian Church, she especially loved her Bible class and its members. Doing things with and for people made her happy.

Survivors include her husband, Henry Webster; son, Patrick and his wife

Gwen Webster; four grandchildren, Rick (wife, Lisa), Anna (husband, Joshua), Max and Rachel; four great-grandchildren, James and Madison Foxworth, Jones and Charlotte Edwards; a sister, Jane Copeland Williams; brothers, Bill and Bob Copeland.
