Colonel Jon H. Robinett, U. S. Army Retired, passed away at his home on Tuesday, March 3, 2026.

Born May 17, 1949 in Conway, Col. Robinett was the son of the late Harold Robinett and the late Margaret McCormack Robinett. He obtained his Masters Degree from Clemson University and joined the military where he rose to the rank of Colonel during a thirty year career. Upon retirement from the military Jon dedicated twenty-four years to teaching in the public school system, a job that he excelled in.

In addition to his parents, Col. Robinett was predeceased by his brother, Daniel Robinett, and his sisters, Sue Smith and Peggy Cullens.

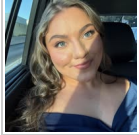
