



## Jordan Smith

March 19, 1969 - June 27, 2014

Jordan Derrick Smith, age 45, died on Friday, June 27, 2014, at his home in Atlanta, GA.

Mr. Smith, born in Myrtle Beach, was the son of Bulah Smith-Gause and the late Jordan Derrick Smith, Sr. He was a member of Belin United Methodist Church, and worked in the healthcare industry. He is preceded in death by his father.
