Conway... Joseph Theodore Causey passed away July 15, 2019 surrounded by his family. He was born in Horry County, a son of the late Verna Cooper Causey and Theo Causey. Joe, better known as "Coach Causey," grew up in Conway playing baseball and spent most of his life sharing his talents and wisdom coaching. He spent time in the Pittsburg Pirates organization before joining the United States Marine Corps in 1966. Joe was a Vietnam Veteran. Coach Causey had a passion for instilling faith and values in youth through the game and served as a coach for the Conway Dixie League, the American Legion Post 111, and founded the Junior American Legion Post 111 in SC in 2003. His favorite professional player, Willie Mays, was an inspiration to his gentle spirit. He spent countless hours mentoring young men on the field, in the batting cages, and in the game of life. Joe enjoyed gardening, golf, spending time with his family, and he was an avid pet lover.

Heroes get remembered but legends never die.

Joe was predeceased by his beloved wife of 40 years, Nancy Jones Causey, and a brother, Ray Causey. He is survived by his children, Clay Causey and Ashley Proctor (John); niece, Tracy Brown (Joe) who was more like a daughter to him; a special nephew, Mark Beverly; his grandchildren, Briggs Causey, Cameron Causey, Kinley Knox Proctor and Jones Clemson Proctor; sister, Anne Beverly; and brother, Lindsey Causey (Phyllis); and several

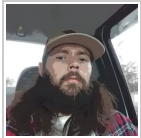
