Joseph Dezzutti age 90, died on Friday, January 20, 2017.

Born in Endicott , New York, he was pre-deceased by his loving wife of 65 years Mary A. Dezzutti in July, his parents Joseph and Corina and an infant brother Joseph.

Joseph was a veteran of World War II, attaining the rank of Captain and retired in 1984 from IBM Federal Systems Division after 33 years of service. He was a member of Precious Blood of Christ Catholic Church. He and his wife moved to Pawleys Island in 1986.
