Joseph Oliver Lewis, age 64, passed away Friday, January 14, 2022 following a motorcycle accident near Bucksport.

Born August 18, 1957 in Conway, he was the son of Doretha Gasque Lewis and the late W.M. Henry Lewis, Jr.

Mr. Lewis was a 1975 graduate of Conway High School. He then went into the military and served his country for almost ten years. He worked as a UPS driver for 24 years. Mr. Lewis was an active member of Bakers Chapel Baptist Church, where he served in the sound room and was in charge of servicing the church bus.

Along with paternal and maternal grandparents and father, Mr. Lewis was predeceased by a three-month-old brother.

Surviving in addition to his mother is his daughter, Brittany Lewis; granddaughter, Breana Gibson; brothers, W.M. "Harold" Lewis, Arnold Wayne Lewis; and his sister, Sandra Kate Lewis.

Funeral services will be held at 2:00 PM Monday, January 17, 2022 at Bakers

Chapel Baptist Church with Rev. Jeremy Todd officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery.

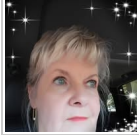

On Friday I was driving home in my car to Conway after a meeting in Charleston. A few miles north of Mt. Pleasant he passed me. As a long-time motorcycle rider I noted his clothing and the classic Honda ST that he rode. His style was smooth and skilled. His speed appropriate. I occasionally could see his taillight a few miles ahead of me all the way to Georgetown and then beyond. I arrived at the accident scene just as emergency vehicles we pulling up. Although we do not yet know the details of the accident, I urge everyone reading this to support efforts to end distracted car driving (i.e., limit cell phone use) and also support efforts to educate car drivers about motorcycles. I wish that I had met Joseph Lewis as I think we shared some things in common.
