The family requests that memorial donation be made to Heavenly Grace Ministries, 5288 Peachtree Rd, Myrtle Beach, SC 29588.

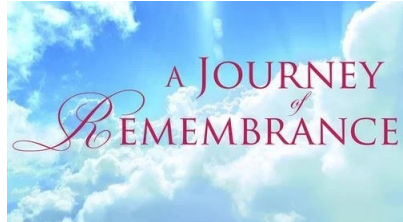
