



## Josephine Bounds

August 30, 1924 - June 16, 2015

Mrs. Josephine D. Bounds, 90, passed away Tuesday, June 16, 2015 at Anderson Oaks Assisted Living Center following a brief illness.

Born August 30, 1924 in Conway, Jo was the daughter of the late John Peter Dunn and the late Bertha Belle Causey Dunn. She was first married to the late Edwin Murray Johnson, Sr. and then to the late Earl Henry Bounds.

Jo graduated from Conway High School and attended classes at HGTC. After retiring from International Paper with 34 years of service she received her Real Estate Broker's License. She was an active member of Conway Centenary United Methodist Church and sang in the church choir. She further shared her musical talent in the Carolina Master Chorale, the Sweet Adelines, the XYZ Choir and the B.A.L.L. Club of First Baptist Church Conway, and the Myrtle Beach Community Choir. Her other church activities included serving as Trustee and serving on the PPRC, the Council, and the Nominations Committee. She was also a member of the Martha Circle, United Methodist Women. Jo also held memberships in the Peter Horry Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution and the Conway Chapter of the United Daughters of the Confederacy, serving as president for two terms.
