Joshua Jonathan Krechel, 88 of Indigo Creek died Wednesday, April 29, 2009 at Grand Strand Regional Medical Center. Born in Lehighton, PA, he was the son of the late David and Mary Krechel. Mr. Krechel had worked with the Civilian Conservation Corp prior to be appointed to the US Merchant Marine Academy in Kings Point, NY. He served in the US Merchant Marines and the US Navy during World War II. Mr. Krechel was a Kings Point Alumni. He was the retired chief power engineer with Riegel Paper. Mr. Krechel was one of the founders of Oak Hill Golf Club in Milford, NJ and served as their first president. He was a member of Frenchtown, NJ F&AM Orion Lodge, 32nd degree in Trenton, NJ, member of 100F Jordan Lodge in Schneckville, PA, Water Federation of New Jersey Water Environmental Protection Agency and the NACCA Civilian Conservation Corp.
