



## Julious Steve Thompson

Julious Stephen "Steve" Thompson, age 84, of Antioch Rd., died Tuesday, August 22, 2006 at his residence. Born September 4, 1921, in Bucksville, SC, he was the eldest son of the late Fred Thompson, Sr., and Ina Owens Thompson. Mr. Thompson attended Clemson University when it was a military college, after which he taught agriculture at Salem and Gable High Schools. He was a US Navy veteran having served in WW II in the European Theatre on the island of Corsica and in La Maddalena, Italy. Upon returning home, he was an agriculture teacher for the Veterans Administration in Conway. In subsequent years, he was an electrician for International Paper Company in Georgetown, SC, a merchant in Bucksport and Conway, SC, and later retired as a U.S.D.A. inspector. He maintained farming interests throughout his life, receiving recognition and awards in agriculture. Mr. Thompson was predeceased on October 2, 2000, by his wife of 58 years, Roberta Calhoun Thompson; a brother, Fred Thompson, Jr. and a half-brother, Charles Thompson. Survivors include: a daughter, Marcia Thompson Hinson and husband, David, of Gresham, SC; two sons, Craig Thompson and wife, Sharon, of Murrells Inlet, SC, Michael Thompson and wife, Patty Burnette, of Conway, SC; six grandchildren, Aubrey Hinson, Ronald Hinson, Joshua Thompson, Georgia Thompson, Ashley Clark and Zachary Clark; two great-grand-grandchildren, Audrey Hinson and Kyle Johnson; a sister, Ina Lee Thompson Cox of Conway, SC; a half-brother, Sidney Thompson of Myrtle Beach, SC and a half-sister, Etah Thompson Kirkpatrick of Rock Hill, SC.
