Mr. Julius Inman, Sr., 95, passed away Monday, January 29, 2018.

Born April 24, 1922, in North Charleston, SC, Mr. Inman was the son of the late Walton Wilreed Inman and the late Ruth Elizabeth Jenerette Inman. He was a U. S. Navy veteran serving in WWII and a member of the VFW. Prior to retirement, Mr. Inman was employed by International Paper Company, Woodlands Division, for 38 years. He was a member of Lakewood Baptist Church, the Pine Tree Club, and Quarter Century Society. Mr. Inman was a member and past president of the Charleston Chapter of the National Association of Accountants. He was a graduate of Conway High School.
