GARDEN CITY BEACH...Justin Alan Sipe, age 23 of Colonial Circle, died Saturday, February 4, 2006 at MUSC in Charleston. Born October 19, 1982 in Gastonia, NC the son of Alan Reid and Jane Blankenship Sipe. During his courageous 23 year battle with Cystic Fibrosis, he never complained or questioned why he had been stricken with this genetic disease. Justin tried to live his life to the fullest and only his closest friends knew what a battle he was dealing with. Justin graduated from Socastee High School in 2000, where he played trumpet in the marching band. Justin earned his Associate Degree in Criminal Justice from Horry-Georgetown Tech., and almost earned his Bachelors Degree from Charleston Southern University. He was an avid hunter and gun enthusiast. Justin was happiest in the outdoors. He enjoyed his summer job at Downwind Sails, working with the jet skis and customers on the beach. One of Justin's fondest memories was the Texas hunting trip that he and his Dad took in October of 2004. Justin killed a Syka Buck with a bow and arrow. Justin's family would like to express their love and thanks to all his friends and caregivers for being at his side through the years. A special thanks to Dr. Patrick Flume, Ms. Sue Gray and the staff at MUSC, and to Ms. Angie Harris of Garden City. Surviving in addition to his parents of Garden City Beach are a sister: Michelle Christenson and husband, Andy of Garden City Beach; one adored nephew: Kade Christenson; one adored niece: Kammy Christenson; grandparents: Reid and Betty Sipe of Kings Mountain, NC and Carolyn Blankenship of Gastonia, NC; and a number of special aunts, uncles,
