Kandy was the beloved wife of her husband, Eddie Larrimore, who stood faithfully by her side through every season. She was the proud and loving mother of her cherished children, Kassie Roscoe and Ty Larrimore, and the adoring mother-in-law to Ryan Roscoe. Her grandson, Sawyer Roscoe, blessed her with the sweetest name—GaGa—and filled her later years with immeasurable joy and purpose.

Kandy's love extended to her many nieces and nephews, each of whom she treasured deeply.

Creative in every sense, Kandy found joy in crafting, decorating, and turning ordinary spaces into something beautiful. She had exceptional taste and a

Her world was made complete by Jesus first, and right next to Him was Kassie, Ty, and Sawyer. Her faith anchored her life, and she was a proud member of CCOG. Two scriptures were especially dear to her heart:

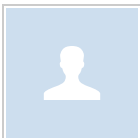
