WAMPEE...Mrs. Kathleen Stevens Hardwick , wife of the late Horry Hardwick, passed away Thursday, January 1, 2009 at her home following an illness.

Mrs. Hardwick was born in Wampee, SC a daughter of the late William Harley Stevens and the late Mary Todd Stevens. She hailed from the Stevens' family, famous for opening the first Stevens' Oyster Roast. Mrs. Hardwick and her husband, Horry, found an abandoned building on the bank of the Waccamaw River and seized the opportunity to make their dream a reality. This led to the establishment of Horry's Restaurant in 1957. Mrs. Hardwick has been the owner and operator since its creation. Her customers through the years became her close friends and part of her extended family. She was also a member of Mt. Leon Baptist Church in Longs. In addition to her husband, she was predeceased by two sisters: Versie Carter and Esther Stevens, and one brother: Leo Stevens.

Survivors include one daughter: Lisa Hardwick Permenter and her husband Kit of Wampee; two grandchildren: Shaye and Alle Permenter of Wampee; and many nieces and nephews.

The family will receive friends Saturday, January 3, 2009 from 6-8 PM at Ward Funeral Home in Loris.
