Conway--Kenneth Charles Biddle, age 90, of Lakeside Drive, died Monday, September 7, 2009 at his residence. Mr. Biddle was born in Nanton, Alberta, Canada, a son of the late Charles Martin Biddle and Elizabeth Ross Biddle. He was employed by Colyear Motor Sales Company in Sacramento, CA and later owned and operated his own NAPA auto parts store in Placerville, CA until his retirement in 1976. Mr. Biddle was of the Presbyterian Faith. He was a US Army Air Corp Veteran of WWII. Mr. Biddle was assigned to the newly formed 373rd Bomb Squadron in January 1942, better known as The Flying Tigers. They left the US in early 1943 for the China, Burma, India Theater as a replacement squadron for General Claire Chennault's Bomb Group. He was stationed at four different airfields during his time in China overseeing the food preparation for the pilots. The squadron supported Chinese ground troops fighting the Japanese and also attacked Japanese airfields and supply depots in China for two years. After Okinawa was secured, the 373rd participated in operations against the Japanese home islands until the war ended. Mr. Biddle was preceded in death by his wife, Hyrtha Carbrey Biddle. Surviving are one son, Larry Biddle and wife Virginia of Conway; three grandchildren, Kenneth C. Biddle, II and wife Kimberly of Conway, Jessamine B. Johnson and husband Glenn of Myrtle Beach and James Marshall Biddle and wife Courtney of Conway and; six great-grandchildren, Lauren Biddle, Chadwick Johnson, Savannah Johnson, Olivia Biddle, Harrison Biddle and Benjamin Biddle; and several nieces and nephews. A funeral service will be held 10:00 AM Friday at

St. Pauls Episcopal Church with Rev. Julian T. "Tripp" Jeffords III and Rev. Loran Bulla officiating. The family will receive friends from 6:00 PM until 8:00 PM Thursday at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Larry L. Biddle.
