Kenneth Hayes Vinson, age 65, of Hwy. 905, died Wednesday, January 3, 2007 at Conway Medical Center. Mr. Vinson was born December 17, 1941 in Union, S.C., a son of the late Douglas Hayes and Elnora Rector Vinson. He graduated from Union High School and the University of South Carolina with a baccalaureate in Business Administration-Marketing. Kenneth was a certified financial planner associated with American Express for the greater part of his business career. He served on the board of Deacons and as chairman of the Stewardship Committee of Kingston Presbyterian Church. Kenneth was a lifelong Rotarian from his high school days as a junior Rotarian to President of the Conway Rotary Club and recognized as a Ten Star Rotarian. He was influential in establishing and maintaining the Conway Rotary Club's Scholarship Program for the needy community students attending Coastal Carolina University and Horry-Georgetown Technical Education College. He served as President and on the Board of Trustees of the Horry County Museum Foundation and served on the Legacy Council of Coastal Carolina University.
