Mr. Kenneth Gerald Westbury, Sr., 78, passed away Tuesday, September 30, 2014 at the Georgia War Veterans Home.

Born March 23, 1936, in Conway, SC, Mr. Westbury was the son of the late Lawrence Graham and Florine Thompson Westbury. He was predeceased by a brother, LaRue Westbury, who is buried in the Price Cemetery with family and relatives.
