Kevin Cusker, age 79, died Tuesday, September 1, 2020 at Tidelands Waccamaw Community Hospital.

Born in Queens, New York, Kevin was a son of the late John and Ann Cusker. Kevin served in the US Army where he trained dogs as a Military Police Officer. After serving in the Army, he joined the New York Police Department 13th Precinct. He was with the NYPD from 1967 until he retired in 1982. Kevin and Muriel later moved to Dingmans Ferry, PA where they lived for 15 years before moving to Murrells Inlet, SC in 2008. He was a member of St. Michaels Catholic Church, Carolina Shields, 1013 Club, Elks Lodge, Moose Lodge, the American Legion, and the VFW. Kevin is preceded in death by his wife, Muriel Cusker.
