Mr. Wendell came to the United States at 7 months old and was raised in Stamford, CT. He attended all Stamford Schools. He joined the Army in 1966 at age 19 and was in the 101st Airborne Screaming Eagles. Mr. Wendell served in Vietnam from 1967-1968, he was wounded twice in Vietnam and received a "Bronze Star" for meritorious achievement against hostile forces. He received a "Purple Heart" and then again received a 2nd "Purple Heart" for wounds received in action. Mr. Wendell worked for Williamson Transportation in Stamford and worked for the city of Stamford, CT. He moved to Myrtle Beach, SC in October 2000 and worked for Walmart in maintenance. He also worked for New South Lumber and Coastal Concrete as a driver. Surviving in addition to his mother is his wife, Marianne S. Wendell; a sister, Penny Wendell and his nephew, Jason Sanone.
