Myrtle Beach, SC...Kevin B. Seymour, age 53, passed away Wednesday, January 1, 2014 at Waccamaw Community Hospital in Murrells Inlet, SC.

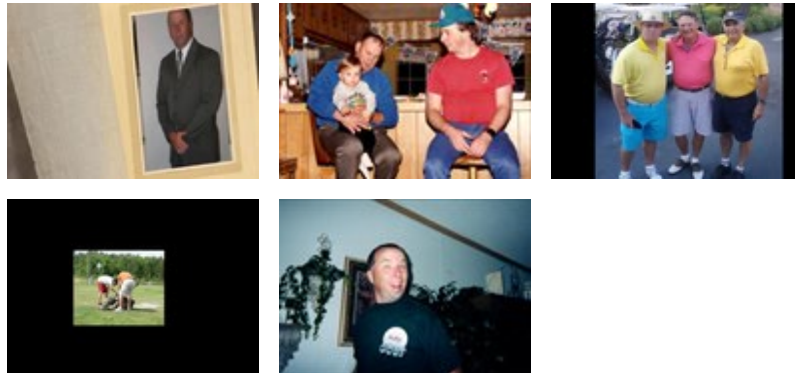

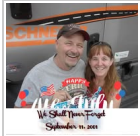
