



## L. Brice Hardwick

May 13, 1932 - October 12, 2018

L. Brice Hardwick peacefully passed away on Friday, October 12, 2018, surrounded by his loving family. The son of the late Charlie and Claude Rabon Hardwick, Brice was born in Cool Springs and educated at Aynor High School and Coastal Carolina University. He was a veteran of the Korean War and enjoyed serving in the Army and Air Force Reserves for over thirty-nine years. Brice had a long and varied career working in Charleston at American Tobacco Company before relocating to Conway where he was an Insurance Investigator with Retail Credit Company. In 1974, he accepted an offer to be the Agency Manager of Horry-Loris Farm Bureau from which he retired in 1996. Thoroughly enjoying his years of retirement, Brice filled each day with activities he enjoyed - working on his farm, tending his herd of Black Angus cows, remodeling homes, and rebuilding antique cars. Additionally, Brice was a longtime, faithful member of Maple Baptist Church where he served in many capacities including Deacon and Trustee.

Surviving are his children, Julie Ann Hardwick and Jeffrey Bryce Hardwick, his nephew, Greggory Myles Hardwick (Kathy), and nieces Karen Hardwick Shelley (Mrs. Windell Shelley), Sallye Elizabeth Brown Prince (Mrs. E.E. 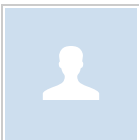
