July 5, 1921 - April 12, 2013

CONWAY...Mr. Lacy Keith Hucks, Sr., age 91, passed away Friday evening, April 12, 2013. Mr. Hucks was born in Aynor, a son of the late Ed Hucks, Sr. and the late Nolie Allen Hucks. He was a member of the First Baptist Church of Conway and was a United States Navy Veteran of World War II. Prior to retirement, he was the Business Manager and Purchasing Agent for the Horry County School District for 20+ years. Mr. Hucks was a member of Conway Rotary Club and the American Legion for over 60 years, a distinguished member of the Horry County Historical Society, one of the first to sit on the Horry County Council, one of the founding stockholders of Apache Family Campground and Holiday Travel Park (now Myrtle Beach Travel Park.) Mr. Hucks was also a lifelong promoter of Horry County through his work with the Myrtle Beach Campground Assoc, Hotel /Motel Assoc., a past Director of the Canadian- American Days Festival activities that were once held in M.B., and participating with the Local and State Chamber of Commerce. Most of all Mr. Hucks used all that he had to give back to all his relatives, friends, co-workers, community, and the family he loved so much. Thanks Dad. He was predeceased by his wife of 60 years: Jeannine A. Hucks, two brothers and three sisters Calbreth Hucks, Allen Hucks, Florine Hardee, Edna Floyd, and Albertine Squires.
