Larry L. Kolman age 71, died Tuesday, December 17, 2013 at Waccamaw Community Hospital.

Mr. Kolman was born on February 17, 1942 in Columbus, OH to Delores Kolman and the late Lewis Kolman. Larry attended Ohio State University then spent 35 years with the Retail Clerks and United Food and Commercial Workers International Union. During that time he worked tirelessly to improve the lives and working conditions of working men, women and children. He retired as the Regional Director of Region 4 and as International Vice President. Larry often met with the leadership of both political parties to help ensure that all Americans had a voice in their government.

Larry enjoyed being an umpire and coaching little league for many years in Westmont, NJ. After retirement he loved to play golf and was an avid fan of the Ohio State Buckeyes, Cleveland Browns, Pittsburgh Pirates and the Los Angeles Lakers and Kings.

Surviving in addition to his mother are his loving wife, of 51 years, Nancy; son, TL Kolman and partner August Vivirito of Van Nuys, California; daughter, Melody Kolman-Almas and husband, David Almas of Columbus, Ohio; sister, Cheryl Newman of Columbus, Ohio, and many friends.
