



Larry A. McDowell

August 13, 1947 - January 30, 2023

Mr. Larry A. McDowell, 75, husband of Norma Boyd McDowell, passed away Monday, January 30, 2023 at McLeod Hospice House following a prolonged illness.

Born August 13, 1947 in Loris, Larry was the son of the late Worth Austin McDowell and the late Mary Leona Mishoe McDowell. His first job after being honorably discharged from the Army during the Vietnam era was with the United States Postal Service. He worked his way up through the ranks and retired as Postmaster after 37 years of service. Larry was a long-time member of Langston Baptist Church and served in many capacities over the years, including deacon.

Mr. McDowell was predeceased by his parents; and his brothers, Junior McDowell, W. D. McDowell, Jimmy Dale McDowell, and Douglas McDowell.

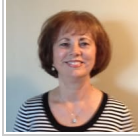
