Lawrence "Larry" Phillip Greene, Sr., age 63, died Thursday, January 9, 2014 surrounded by his loving family at Tideland Hospice House.

Mr. Greene was born in Keansburg, NJ to the late Richard and Shirley Greene. He is predeceased by his son Christopher Greene.

A highly decorated Vietnam Veteran, Mr. Greene served as a Sergeant in the United States Army. He worked as a police officer with the DC Police Department retiring after 16 years on the force. Mr. Greene served the state of South Carolina for 18+ years as a Lt. Colonel with the South Carolina State Guard. As a District 11 Sports Official, Mr. Greene officiated football, baseball and softball events.

Survivors include his loving wife of 32 years, Chris Greene; sons, Lawrence Greene, Jr. and his wife Missy, Georgetown; Roger Greene, Pawleys Island; grandchildren, Sharon Lynn Brimhall, Zoriah Brooke Greene, Preston Phillip Greene; 7 brothers and 1 sister.

A memorial service will be held 11:00 AM, Tuesday, January 14, 2014 at Goldfinch Funeral Home, Litchfield-Pawleys Chapel with Pastor Benji Wham officiating. The family will receive friends at the funeral home one hour prior to the service.
