Lawrence (Larry) Carl Longo, born September 11, 1944 in Erie, Pennsylvania, died from heart complications Wednesday, April 23 in the early morning.

Larry served in the U.S. Navy from 1963-1967. He has resided in Murrells Inlet since 2006 and in South Carolina since 1991. He retired from the Savannah River Plant, Aiken, South Carolina, in 2010, and for the past four years worked for Universal Security Services as a guard supervisor at Heritage Plantations in Pawleys Island.

He is survived by his wife, Lee Bollinger, as well as a son, Michael Longo, and step-children, Deirdre Vasile and Timothy Pattillo and a sister, Linda Schafnit.
