Lawrence Walter "Larry" McPhee, 89, passed away on Tuesday, April 27, 2021 after a courageous battle with Alzheimer's.

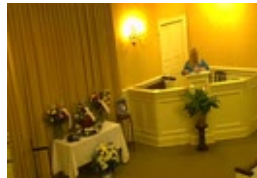
