July 9, 1931 - May 25, 2012

Leon Dell Robbins age 80, died Friday May 25, 2012 at Grand Strand Regional Medical Center.

Mr. Robbins was born in Milwaukee, Wisconsin to the late Leonarda and Dell Joseph Robbins. He served in the United States Marine Corp from 1948-1952 and was a veteran of the Korean War. He was a 1956 graduate of General Motors Institute now known as Kettering University. Mr Robbins was a member of Belin Memorial United Methodist Church and also a member of Wachesaw Plantation. He was preceded in death by his sister Mary Ann Hagler and a sister in law Sally Robbins.
