Leonard Keith "Lenny" Moore, 56, passed away in Nicaragua, Central America on Monday, November 15, 2010, following a very courageous battle with cancer.

Lenny was of the Catholic Faith. He graduated from Loris High School and attended Clemson University. He was employed with Badger Sportswear in Nicaragua, Central America.
